



Regolamento Napoli City Half Marathon 2022

ASD Napoli Running, under the patronage of the City of Naples, organizes the 9th edition of the Naples City Half Marathon, a race covering a distance of 21.097 km and included in the WA, AIMS and FIDAL calendars:

The race will be held in Naples on Sunday, February 27, 2022, meeting at 7:30 a.m. at the Mostra d'Oltremare expo center and starting at 9:00 a.m. from Viale J. F. Kennedy

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ATHLETES REGISTERED IN ITALY

In accordance with the “Rules for the Organization of Events” issued by FIDAL, participation is limited to athletes registered in Italy, aged 18 years and over, who are in possession of one of the following requirements:

- Athletes registered for 2022 to companies affiliated with FIDAL;
- Athletes in possession of a ‘Runcard’ (valid as sports insurance and permit to compete) and limited to those aged 20 years or over;
- Athletes registered for a Sports Promotion Organization (Athletic Section) and in possession of a ‘Runcard-EPS’.
- Fitwalkers owning a Fidal or Runcard FIDAL who own a medical certificate for a light Athletic discipline. If they don’t own the documents mentioned above, they can only participate in the non-competitive relay race.
- Disabled Athletes registered for 2022 with companies affiliated to one of the following Paralympic Sports Federations recognized by the CIP (Italian Paralympic Committee): FISPES (Italian Federation of Paralympic and Experimental Sports), FISDIR (Italian Federation of Intellectual and Relational Disability Sports) and FSSI (Silent Sports Federation of Italy). In this case, the athletes assigned to the club copy of the valid membership (2022), or declaration on headed paper of the card with stamp and signature of the President. Athletes with disabilities, for safety reasons, will start from the last grid and Hand Bikes will not be allowed.

However, owners of a Runcard, in order to participate, must present a valid medical certificate of fitness suitable for athletics, the original of which has to be presented to the organizers and then kept, in copy, in the deeds of the organizing company of each event.

STROLLER

Strollers are allowed to participate in the maximum number of 50 participants who will start, for safety reasons, behind all participants. Pushers must be registered.



PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ATHLETES NOT REGISTERED IN ITALY

Italian/foreign athletes who are not registered in Italy can participate, if over 18 years of age, they, however, must adhere to at least one of the following requirements:

- Be in possession of the RUNCARD FIDAL combined with a medical certificate that can be issued in one's own country, but the same tests required by Italian law must have been carried out.
- Be registered for 2022 with Foreign Athletics Federations, affiliated to World Athletics; in this case they will have to send, upon registration, (via e-mail to info@napolirunning.com or bring the document when collecting the bib) the self-certification of membership. (which must then be signed in original when collecting the bib.)

The medical certificate for non-resident foreigners can be issued in one's own country, using the facsimile available on the website www.napolirunning.com and www.runcard.com.

FOREIGN ATHLETES WITH TOURIST-SPORTS PURPOSES

Non-registered foreign athletes can participate in the non-competitive event without sending the medical certificate with exclusion from the ranking and from the foreseen awards. This type of participation only provides for the completion of the self-certification (the liability waiver form), to be sent together with an identity document to the address info@napolirunning.com.

REGULARIZING YOUR REGISTRATION

Athletes with an IRREGULAR REGISTRATION will have to regularize their standing before retrieving their number bib (valid membership and certificate) **updating the FIDAL portal** (either directly or through the president of the company to which they associate). In the case that an athlete is suspended due to an expired medical certificate, presentation of the original will not be deemed valid as an authorization to compete.

Any athlete without a regular registration will be unable to retrieve the number bib and chip, only the race pack will be given to them.

Athletes competing with a **Runcard** but suspended due to an expired medical certificate will be able to mend their standing by bringing with them a copy of a medical certificate for competitive athletics.

- € 30 up to the 2000th member
- € 35 from 2001 to 4000 enrolled
- € 40 over 4001st
- € 50 on Friday 25th and Saturday 26th at the Expo

* Enternow portal rights are excluded.

RELAY (for two people)

- € 40 up to the 100th member
- € 50 from the 101st member

THE REGISTRATION FEE COVERS THE FOLLOWING

- race bib;
- insurance;
- technical and medical assistance;
- official race pack of the event;
- refreshments along the route;
- final refreshment bag;
- official program and information materials;
- chip and timing service;
- path homologation;
- online diploma;

- participation medal (for classified athletes);
- bag deposit service (N.B. It is allowed to deposit only small backpacks with post-race change);
- changing rooms for men and women

Any promotions or discounts relating to the purchase of bibs is or will be published on the website www.napolirunning.com

It is specified that the services included in the registration fee as specified above may be subject to limitations in compliance with the National, Local and / or Federal legislation in force on the date of the event.

The organizer reserves the right to vary the cost of registering for the event if additional services are added at its discretion or in compliance with Federal, National or Local regulations.

CLOSURE OF REGISTRATIONS



Online registrations will close on February 23 2022 at midnight, or before reaching the maximum race capacity.

NUMBER BIB PICK-UP

The number bib can be picked up at the stands located within the Mostra d'Oltremare expo center either on Friday, February 25, between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., on Saturday, February 26 between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., or on Sunday, **February 27, between 6:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m.**

Collecting the number bib on Sunday, tough not recommended, is reserved for athletes and nonregional companies granted they have an actual need and have properly registered in the days before.

In accordance with the provisions **of the last State Police circular** for the organization of public events, the collection of number bibs must be carried out personally by every single registered athlete upon presentation of an identification document; for reasons of public order it is not possible for any athlete to pick up number bibs for other runners.

Exceptionally any given athlete will be allowed to pick up at most one number bib in addition to his or her own by downloading the “single proxy” form from www.napolirunning.com.

Pick-up for companies is allowed only on Friday by appointment. Write to deleghe@napolirunning.com

STARTING GRIDS

Runners will be divided into six grids at the start. Bib numbers will be assigned in relation to the best time declared during registration on the distance of a half marathon and achieved in the previous two years.

Failure to report said time, or reporting an incorrect or false time, means the runner will be starting from the last grid.

It will not be possible to request a grid following registration.

It is not allowed to enter a different grid from the one given; any runner doing so will be liable to disqualification.

Access to the grids will be manned by the competition judges and closed at 8:45 am.

The grids will be set in the following way:

The number and composition of the grids may be changed at the discretion of the organizer or in any case in compliance with the directives of the relevant authorities or the legislation dictated in contrast to the COVID-19 epidemic.

RACE PACK

Athletes may pick up their race pack by exhibiting their number bib at the stand at the Expo.

CHANGING ROOMS AND STORAGE

Men and women indoor dressing rooms equipped with storage areas will be set up in the immediate vicinity of the start and finish area. Entry is granted upon display of the number bib. The organization is in no way responsible for objects left inside the stored bags

REFRESHMENT POINTS

Refreshments will be provided at the start and finish, as well as along the course, in accordance with FIDAL regulations. As well as along the course at the fifth, tenth, fifteenth kilometer, upon arrival, the final refreshment will be set up with water, energy drink, bar and fruit.

TIME LIMIT

The **Napoli City Half Marathon** will have a time limit of **3 hours**.

There will be 2 gates:

- Km 10: for those who don't reach it at 10.30 am (9min/km)
- Km 14: for those who don't reach it at 11.10 am (9min/km)

Any runner exceeding said time limit will be required to withdraw from the competition and to remove the bib number. If the athlete decides to continue anyway, he or she will do so outside of the competition and at his/her own risk and danger, relieving the organization of any kind of responsibility. The athlete won't be classified.

THE TIMEKEEPING CHIP

Your time will be recorded by means of an electronic chip which allows to also record the partial and the official times.



The chip is for personal use and cannot be exchanged.

Any runner who won't run past given checkpoints will be disqualified. Under penalty of exclusion from the rankings, the chip placed on the bib number must not be removed for any reason.

TIMING AND RANKINGS

Time measurement and processing of the rankings is done by Timing Data Service (TDS) srl; the same are validated by the Chief Technical Judge/Appeals Judge. The final rankings, excluding the placements that give the right to a money prize, will be processed according to real time (time of passage from the starting mat to the arrival mat).

No cash prizes may be provided to holders of a Runcard or Runcard EPS (as per FIDAL regulations). In such cases, in lieu of cash prizes or the like, athletes will receive prizes in sports goods, foodstuff or crafts. A cash prize will not be paid.

Individual prizes in euros will be paid out by April 30, 2022, in accordance with the applicable FIDAL regulations.

Athletes receiving prizes will have to fill out a form before the March 31 2022 indicating, in addition to their personal data, the details of a valid identification document. The form can be downloaded at www.napolirunning.com

PRIZES FOR COMPANIES

The top 10 companies with at least 30 ranked athletes in relation to the number of athletes who cross the finish line validly, will be awarded:

- The first company 750 €
- The second company 600 €
- The third company 500 €
- The fourth company 450 €
- The fifth company € 350
- The sixth company € 250
- The seventh company € 200
- The eighth company € 150
- The ninth company € 100
- The tenth company 50 €

All participating companies affiliated with FIDAL will compete in the ranking. In case of a tie, the corresponding prizes will be added and subdivided among the entitled parties. **Company prizes will be paid out by April 30, 2021.**

The companies to be awarded must fill in a specific form by March 31, 2022 indicating, in addition to the personal data, the details of an identification document. The form can be downloaded from the website www.napolirunning.com.

CATEGORY PRIZES

Prizes in sports goods, foodstuff or crafts will be awarded to the first 3 in the following men's Master Categories: SM23-34, SM35, SM40, SM45, SM50, SM55, SM60, SM65, SM70, and beyond.

Prizes in sports goods, foodstuff or crafts will be awarded to the first 3 in the following women's Master Categories: SF23-34, SF35, SF40, SF45, SF50, SF55, SF60, SF65, SF70, and beyond.

The prizes must be collected at the end of the race. Failure to do so will void one's right to the prize.



RACE CANCELLATION

If the tender is cancelled, moved to another date and / or, in any case, not carried out for reasons not dependent on and / or not related to the will of the Organization, including the revocation of the authorization to carry it out by the competent Public Bodies, the registered will have nothing to claim from the ASD Napoli Running not even by way of reimbursement of expenses incurred, considering the signing of the registration application also as a waiver of any claim for compensation for damage and / or compensation and / or any claim to reintegrate and / or satisfy any financial damage suffered and undergoing. In the event of cancellation and / or postponement of the race, the registration made may be used for the new established date or may be used for the race to be held the following year.

NUMBER BIB TRANSFER

It will be possible to transfer one's number bib to another runner:

- By February 20, 2022, at no charge
- Between February 21 and February 23, 2022, upon payment of a €5 processing fee.

No transfer will be allowed beyond this date.

BIB TRANSFER TO ANOTHER EVENT ASD NAPOLI RUNNING

By February 16, 2022, it will be possible to transfer the registration to another ASD NAPOLI RUNNING event, such as SORRENTO-POSITANO 2022 with the payment of 10 Euros, upon notification via email and a copy of the attached payment. In this case it will not be possible to collect the race packet inherent to the event in which it was not possible to participate.

INABILITY TO PARTICIPATE

A registration freeze is unavailable.

DATA PROCESSING

Pursuant to EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR) we inform participants of the following:

- the data contained in the registration form is required for registration, to prepare the list of participants, the rankings, the archive, to carry out the services declared in the rules and for the sending of communications;
- not providing the aforementioned data or information will disqualify you from participating in the event;

IMAGE COPYRIGHT

By registering for the Napoli City Half Marathon, the athlete expressly authorizes the Naples Running organization to have the right to use any still or moving image in which he or she may appear when taking part in the race for all visual media, produced and distributed throughout the world and for as long as is permitted by law, regulations, and treaties in force, including any extension that may be made to the allowed period of time.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The management of the event will follow the Regulations "Italy goes back to racing. Temporary organizational protocol not staged ". This document is constantly evolving, so before the event takes place it will be necessary to check for any updates published on the National FIDAL website at the link

It is understood that the issuance of new rules by the Central or Territorial Government may at any time cancel the provisions of the Protocol currently in force.

Anyone with the following symptoms is not allowed to participate:

- fever and / or widespread muscle aches;
- upper and lower respiratory tract symptoms: cough, cold, sore throat, breathing difficulties;
- gastrointestinal symptoms (diarrhea, nausea, etc.)
- disturbances in the perception of odors and tastes (anosmia, dysgeusia)

ATHLETES RESPONSIBILITIES

The runner is responsible for the ownership and custody of his race bib, whose exhibition guarantees the right to use all the services mentioned in this regulation and subsequently communicated.

a) Anyone who, without regular registration, participates without a bib, in addition to being held responsible for damage to persons or property, including himself, will incur sports sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the penal sanctions provided for the crime of " theft "(art. 624. Criminal Code).



b) Anyone who, without regular registration, participates with a counterfeit bib or in any case not compliant with the assignment, or with a bib of another, in addition to being responsible as indicated above, will incur sports sanctions and, moreover, may be subject to the penalties provided for for the crime of "theft" (art. 624. Criminal Code), or, alternatively, for the crime of fraud (art. 640 Criminal Code).

In cases a) and b) the participants may be subject to the penalties provided for the crime of "non-compliance with the provisions of the Authorities" (art. 650 of the criminal code). The aforementioned cases will be found upon verification of photographic and / or video documentation.

DISCLAIMER

The athlete declares that he or she has read the competition rules and accepts its contents in its entirety. The athlete, therefore, declares that they bear all risks arising from participation in the event, such as those resulting from possible falls or impacts with authorized vehicles and/or with other participants, spectators or others, damage resulting from adverse weather conditions, the road surface, and any other type of risk, although not expressly referred to.

As a result of this disclaimer the athlete expressly exempts, in writing, the organizers and individual participants in the organization of the sports event from any liability for any damage or harm resulting from participation in the race and all activities during the three days of the event.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

For the duration of the event there will be a medical assistance service and mobile first aid with on board defibrillator.

DISCLAIMER

The event will take place regardless of the weather conditions and, in any case, at the discretion of the organization.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify these rules at any time due to emerging needs and/or reasons that it deems appropriate for a better organization of the race. Any changes will be, in any case, agreed upon by the Campania CR and the National FIDAL. For any and all matters not covered by these rules, FIDAL's statutory technical regulations will apply. Any changes to services, locations and/or times will be communicated via the website www.napolirunning.com



COMPLAINTS

Any complaints must be submitted, in compliance with the FIDAL and R.T.I. rules, within 30 minutes of the official rankings, accompanied by a fee of 100 EURO which will be returned in the event of acceptance of the complaint. For any unforeseen aspects, refer to the FIDAL rules.

JURISDICTION

The Naples Bureau has jurisdiction for any disputes arising in regard to the application and interpretation of these rules.

UPON REGISTRATION ALL ATHLETES ARE CONSIDERED TO BE AWARE OF THE RULES. FOR ANY TOPIC OR ASPECT NOT COVERED IN THESE RULES, PLEASE REFER TO THE 2019 FIDAL REGULATIONS.

OTHER NON-COMPETITIVE EVENTS

RELAY FOR TWO RUNNERS

On the occasion of the Naples City Half Marathon there will be a non-competitive Relay for two runners. The two participants will cover a 10 km and a 11, 0975 km fraction respectively. The presentation of a certificate of sound and robust constitution is required. The registration fee * is 40 Euros up to the 100th subscriber and 50 Euros from the 101st subscriber (* the rights of the enternow portal are excluded). Registration can be done directly at the Sport Expo between 25 and 26 February. The bib can be transferred free of charge to another participant up to and including February 26th. The registration fee includes, for each participant, the points indicated above under "The registration fee includes".
